

Rules and Regulations of Using the MUG Sports Centre

1. The following Rules and Regulations set forth the rules for the use of the sports facilities belonging to the Medical University of Gdańsk Sports Centre.
2. The above-mentioned facilities can be used free of charge by students in the course of both compulsory and facultative classes as well as sports sections, and also by employees and retired employees of the Medical University of Gdańsk, according to schedule.
3. The sports facilities can be used for a fee by any person, association or company in accordance with a relevant rent agreement.
4. The gymnasium and squash court can be used for a fee by MUG students, MUG interns, MUG employees, members of MUG Academic Sports Club (AZS GUMed), foreign guests at MUG, as well as other persons, in accordance with the current price list (see Attachment 1 to these Rules and Regulations).
5. Only authorised persons, i.e. persons who are holders of either an identification card, a student identification card, or multi-use pass, can enter the MUG Sports Centre premises.
6. Persons under 18 years of age may use the MUG Sports Centre services with the written consent of a parent or a legal guardian.
7. Children under 15 years of age may not enter or use the gymnasium.
8. MUG Sports Centre services may be used by persons whose health condition is deemed suitable to use those services.
9. Persons who intend to avail themselves of the classes offered by MUG Sports Centre should consult a doctor about their health condition.
10. At the MUG Sports Centre premises it is explicitly forbidden to:

- a) consume alcoholic beverages and / or enter while in possession of alcoholic beverages;
- b) use tobacco products;
- c) use drugs / steroids, and / or enter while in possession of drugs / steroids, and / or enter while under the influence of drugs / steroids;
- d) engage in sales of goods and / or services;
- e) bring in animals;
- f) bring in bicycles;
- g) place advertisements.

11. One should follow the detailed Rules and Regulations of use placed in individual sports rooms at MUG Sports Centre.

12. Each person using the MUG Sports Centre services shall bear full financial responsibility for his or her actions and / or omissions that result in damage to the MUG Sports Centre's property.

13. Equipment belonging to MUG Sports Centre should be used according to its purpose and the directions of an instructor or an MUG Sports Centre employee.

14. MUG Sports Centre shall not be liable for any damage to health of persons availing themselves of Akademos Sports Centre classes and / or equipment.

15. MUG Sports Centre shall not be liable for any damage to or loss of any items belonging to a Customer that are left unattended.

16. A Customer is obliged to keep his or her belongings in the available locker rooms only for the duration of stay at MUG Sports Centre.

17. MUG Sports Centre retains its right to suspend classes and / or services when it is required due to technical or other relevant circumstances, about which the Customer shall be notified separately.

18. In the event of non-compliance with these Rules and Regulations, MUG Sports Centre retains its right to remove the Customer from the list without the right to a refund for the services purchased.

19. Prices of multi-use passes, one-time entries and all relevant discounts are specified by the current price list available on the MUG Sports Centre website (<https://sportscenter.mug.edu.pl/>) or at the MUG Sports Centre office.

20. While purchasing a multi-use pass, prices that are valid on the day of purchase apply.

21. In the rooms intended for exercise, one is obliged to use sports shoes with a clean, thick, cushioned sole, as well as a sports outfit.

22. Persons who fail to change shoes will be asked to leave the premises without the right to a refund for the services purchased.

23. The Customer is obliged to have a personal towel, in order to maintain the hygiene of the gymnasium equipment or the mats during fitness classes.

24. Before commencing exercises with the use of the Sports Centre's equipment, the user should check the technical condition of the device intended to be used, for the purpose of maintaining safety, and in case of noticing any defects they should report the fact to an instructor or an employee at the MUG Sports Centre office.

25. MUG Sports Centre retains its right to change the class schedule, to change the instructor, as well as to cancel groups, and to reduce the number of classes.

30. MUG Sports Centre retains its right to introduce changes to these Rules and Regulations.

31. Any complaints and / or suggestions should be directed to the MUG Sports Centre Manager.

The Rules and Regulations are valid as of February 18, 2019.
